There are two ways of reaching the Bambarakanda waterfall. One way is to travel to Kalupahana which is situated on the Balangoda-Haputale Road, turn to Udaweriya travel a further five kilometres to reach the Bambarakanda


from Horton Plains or Ohiya. The Bambarakanda waterfall is 15 kilometres
