ETI launch *Ran Wasi* promotion

A novel savings scheme was launched by ETI Finance Limited yesterday with First Lady Shiranthi Rajapaksa as the Chief Guest at Borella.

Under this scheme, the investment of a Rs.50,000 fixed deposit for a period of 60 months with ETI, would entitle a customer to an interest rate of 10% and a quarter sovereign gold coin. In addition, a 10% interest and a quarter sovereign gold coin could be redeemed on fixed deposits of Rs.250,000 for a period of 15 months only.
