## Chinese bank ICBC tops Forbes Global 2000 list

Chinese bank ICBC knocked US oil giant ExxonMobil from its perch as the world's biggest public company ranking number-one for the first time on the Forbes Global 2000 list. Underscoring the power move by Chinese companies to top global rankings, China Construction Bank leaped 11 spots from last year to the number-two spot on the Forbes list of the world's largest public companies.

"This year's list again reveals the dynamism of global business," said Scott DeCarlo, the list editor.

Forbes said that ICBC– The Industrial and Commercial Bank of China – and CCB were bumped higher in the ranks by double-digit growth in both sales and profits in 2012, although annual profit growth for both banks was the slowest rate since they went public.

ICBC brought in \$37.8 billion in profits on \$2.8 trillion in assets last yeat, while CCB earned \$30.6 billion on \$2.2 trillion in assets. "Most analysts don't expect a banking crisis in China, but rising defaults and shrinking loan profitability are serious threats to the country's banking system," Forbes said. *AFP*
