Undergraduate Scholarships — 2002/2003

APPLICATIONS are invited from eligible Sri Lankan students for the award of Undergraduate scholarships offered by the following countries for the academic year commencing in 2002.

(A) The countries are :

1. China
2. Japan
3. Russia
4. India
5. Pakistan
6. Bangladesh

(B) General eligibility requirements :

Every Candidate —

- (a) Should be a citizen of Sri Lanka.
- (b) Age as indicated under the scholarship scheme.
- (c) Applicants should have passed the G. C. E. (A/L) examination with relevant subjects related to the fields applicant intends to apply.
- (d) Applicants should possess a high proficiency in English.
- (e) Applicants should be in good health.

Applicants those who apply for China and Japan Scholarships are required to sit for competitive examinations, which are conducted by the relevant Embassies in Sri Lanka. These examinations will be held in Colombo and the issuing of admission cards relating to the examinations will be done by the officers of the embassies of China and Japan in Sri Lanka.

01. China

Those candidates who apply for Physics, Engineering, Agriculture and Medicine are required to sit the standard examination in Mathematics, Physics and Chemistry. Those intending to study Economics Trade and Management are required to take up the examination in Mathematics. The examinations will be conducted in English Medium only. Applicants who apply for Arts subjects need not take up this examination.

1.1 Eligibility and applicable conditions :

(c) Agriculture	Not more than 25 years of age on 01.09.2002	Should have passed the GCE (A/L) in four (old syllabus) or three (new syllabus) subjects respectively in the relevant field in one and the same sitting with 2 Credit Passes.
(d) Economics Management Trade	Not more than 25 years of age on 01.09.2002	Should have passed the GCE (A/L) in four (old syllabus) or (new syllabus) three subjects respectively in the relevant field in one and the same sitting with 2 credit Passes.
(e) Arts (No Exam)	Not more than 25 Years of age on 01.09.2002	Should have passed the GCE (A/L) in four (old syllabus) or three (new syllabus) subjects respectively in the relevant field in one and the same sitting with 2 Credit Passes.

1.2 Applicants who wish to follow courses in Art, should have 'A' Pass for Art at GCE (A/L) and should produce their own Paintings to assess their creativity at the interview :

- (a) Successful candidates should be prepared to study the subjects in the Chinese Language before the commencements of teaching the relevant subjects, a knowledge in the Chinese Language will be given for a duration of one year or two.
- (b) The selection examination under reference will be limited to the candidates who possess highest marks at the Advance Level Examination.
- (c) Selected field of study at the beginning will not be changed later under any circumstances.

1.3 Terms and Award :

The Scholarships will provide :

- (a) A monthly maintenance allowances,
- (b) Approved tuition and examination fees,
- (c) A grant for books and apparatus where applicable,
- (d) Free Medical Care,
- (e) Hostel accommodation,
- (f) Travel expenses to China and back will have to be borne by the Candidates.

The interview for the selection for this scholarships will be held in April, 2002.

02. **Japan** (Monbukagakusho) - for Undergraduate Students

2.1 Field of Study :

- (a) Social Sciences and Humanities : Law, Politics, Economics, Business Administration, Education, Sociology, Literature, History, Japanese Language.
- (b) Natural Sciences A - Science (Mathematics, Physics, Chemistry) Electric and Electronic Studies, Mechanical Studies, Civil Engineering and Architecture
Natural Sciences B - Agricultural Studies
Natural Sciences C - Medicine, Dentistry

2.2 Qualifications :

- (i) Applicants should be between 17—22 years of age on 01.04.2003.
- (ii) Applicants should be prepared to follow the course in Japanese Language.
- (iii) Applicants should possess a high proficiency in English.

2.3 Selection :

Selection of candidates will be done on the results of the competitive examination, which is to be conducted by the Japanese Embassy in Sri Lanka. This examination will be held in July, 2002. 15 Candidates will be short-listed on merit basis at the Advance Level Examination to sit for the competitive examination out of the applicants who have applied according to this *Gazette notification*.

2.4 Subjects for the Test :

- (a) Applicants who apply for Social Sciences and Humanities should sit for four subjects.
- (b) Applicants who apply for Natural Science A, B and C should sit for Five Subjects.
Viz. Mathematics, English and Two subjects chosen from among Physics, Chemistry and Biology and the Japanese Language.
Choosing of two subject out of Physics, Chemistry and Biology should be as follows :
Natural Sciences A — Physics, Chemistry
Natural Sciences B — Chemistry, Biology
Natural Sciences C — Chemistry, Biology

2.5 Benefits :

- (a) Air travel to Japan and back,
- (b) A monthly stipend of Yen 142,500,
- (c) An arrival allowance of Yen 25,000,
- (d) Exemption from fees for the entrance examination, tuition fees etc.
- (e) Accommodation facilities.

The interview for the selection for this scholarships will be held in June, 2002.

3.2 Qualifications :

- (i) Age.— should be between 17-22 years of age on 01.04.2003.
- (ii) Applicants should have possess the GCE (A/L) Examination with relevant subjects related to the field applied.
- (iii) Applicants should possess a high proficiency in English.

3.3 Selections :

The Applicants will be short listed on merit basis at the Advance Level Examination and only 30 candidates will be selected to appear for a written test in two subjects in Mathematics and Physics or Chemistry conducted in July, 2002 by the Japanese Embassy in Colombo.

04. India

Candidates may apply for all other fields of study except for Medicine. Students who sat for the A/L Exam. in four subjects should have obtained passes for all four prescribed subjects in one and the same attempt. Others who sat for Advance Level Examination in three Subjects should have obtained passes for all three prescribed subjects in one and the same attempt.

4.1 The prescribed subjects are as follows :

Agriculture and Bio Science	: Physics, Chemistry, Zoology and Botany
Engineering and Physical Science	: Physics, Chemistry, Applied Maths and Pure Maths.
Other fields of Study	: Four Subjects relevant to the desired (Arts, Commerce etc.) field of Study.

4.2 Qualifications :

- (a) Age.— Should be between 19-22 years of age as at 01.09.2002.
- (b) Should possess at least 60% of the total average marks in the relevant 3 or 4 subjects at G. C. E. (A/L) Examination.
- (c) Should have obtained in addition at least a credit pass in English at the G. C. E. (O/L) Examination as the medium of instruction in India is English.
- (d) Should possess high proficiency in English, which will be assessed, at an interview or test to be held before the student is selected for nomination.

5. Russia

5.1 Fields :

All applicants should have G. C. E. (A/L) with aggregate marks not less than 80% of the maximum sum of marks.

Grade A or B Pass is required in Botany, Zoology and Chemistry for Medicine.

Grade A or B pass is required in Mathematics and Physics for Engineering Courses.

Grade A or B pass is required in Mathematics or Economics for Economics and Management Courses.

The age limit for Undergraduate Course is 27 years.

5.2 Method of Selection :

The Selection will be done through and interview after short listing of applications on merit basis at Advance Level Examination.

5.3 Terms and Award :

The scholarship will provide—

- (a) Education free of charge,
- (b) Hostel facilities will be provided at the rate similar to local students. This cost is estimated to be around 10 US.\$ per month.
- (c) Monthly incidental expenses.
- (d) Medical care in accordance with the Russian Federal Law.
- (e) Travel expenses to Russia and back.
- (f) Cost of living expenses for Food, Clothing etc.

06. Bangladesh

Applicants to these seats should possess an average aggregate marks of 65% in Bio Science with Physics, Chemistry and Biology. Should have passed G. C. E. (O/L) & (A/L) examinations not before 1998 and 2001 respectively.

6.3 Age.— Should be 17- 22 of age at 31.05.2002.

6.4 The entire expenditure except the payment of tuition fees in regard to the above seats will have to borne by the selectees.

7. Pakistan - Technical Assistance Programme (PTAP)

7.1 Field of Study - Medicine, Dental (BDS), B. Pharmacy, B. Sc. Engineering.

7.2 Selected candidates will have to pay the tuition fees in par with Pakistan students. Also Air Travel and Expenses on board and lodging etc. are to be paid by the selected candidates.

7.3 Educational Qualifications :

Students who have been successful at the G. C. E. (A/L) 2001 are eligible to apply for these placements.

Medicine/BDS/B. Pharmacy - G. C. E. (A/L) (Physics, Chemistry & Biology) with at least 60% marks.

B. Sc. (Engineering) - G. C. E. (A/L) (Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics) with at least 60% marks.

The interview for the selection for this scholarship will be held in October, 2002.

08. **Pakistan** - Cultural Exchange Programme

8.1 Field of Study - Social Science, Natural Science

(Except MBBS, BDS, Engineering and B. Pharmacy)

8.2 Selected Candidates will have to pay the tuition fees in par with Pakistan students. Also air travel and expenses on board and lodging etc. are to be paid by the selected candidates.

8.3 *Educational qualifications :*

Students who have been Successful at the G. C. E. (A/L) 2001 are eligible to apply for these placements.

Applicants should obtain at least with 60% marks at the G. C. E. (A/L) Examination.

The selection under reference will be limited to the candidates who posses highest marks at the A/L Examination.

The interview for the selection for the scholarships will be held in June, 2002.

09. *Applications.—*

- (b) Separate applications should be forwarded to different countries concerned. Only one application can be forwarded for one country. In the application your choice of subjects should indicate in descending order.

- (e) Applicants should not be students already selected or following a course of study at any university in Sri Lanka or abroad.
- (f) Candidates are required to indicate aggregate Marks received by them at the G. C. E. (A/L) Examination and the gradings obtained for each subject.
- (g) Applicants who wish to apply on the results of G. C. E. (A/L) Examination in 2001 : if aggregate marks are not available should state the gradings obtained for each subject. (eg. A, B & C).
- (h) Closing date :
 - (i) Applications for the scholarships of the Govt. of India will be accepted only up to 21st January, 2002.
 - (ii) Applications for the scholarships of other countries will be accepted only up to 28th February, 2002.
- (i) The conditions laid down in this advertisement are subject to variations in terms of criteria imposed by the awarding countries without prior notice.
- (j) Selected candidates who declined to accept the award after nomination, will not be considered for any other subsequent placement.

APPLICATIONS are hereby invited from citizens of Sri Lanka who possess qualifications mentioned below for the recruitment to the post of Extension Officer of Class II Segment " B " of the Sri Lanka Technological Service in the Department of Export Agriculture. A specimen application form is appended to this notification. Applicants should prepare the application in a paper of A4 size (21 x 30 centimeters) using both sides of the paper and should be sent under registered cover only to reach the " Director of Export Agriculture, Department of Export Agriculture, No. 1095, Sirimavo Bandaranaike Mawatha, Peradeniya " on or before 30th January, 2002.

02. The examination will be held in March 2002 in Colombo only and the date of the examination will be notified by Commissioner-General of the Examinations in due course.

03. The candidates who are presently in State Service should forward their applications through the Head of the Department.

Note.—Complaints made on loss of applications in the post or any postal delays will not be accepted. Candidates who delay the submitting of application until last date of closing applications may do so at their own risk. Receipt of applications will not be acknowledged. The words " Post of Extension Officer " should be written on the left-hand top corner of the envelope.

04. *Salary Scale.*—Post of Extension Officer Class II Segment ' B '. Rs. 51,840—7 x 1,320 — 10 x 1,560 — Rs. 76,680.

05. *Age Limit.*—Should not be less than 18 years or more than 45 years of age as at 30.01.2002. The upper age limit will not apply to employees who are already in Government or Provincial Government Service.

06. *Educational Qualifications.*—Applicants should fulfill at least one of the following technical qualifications :

- (i) Two Year Diploma in Agriculture from the Department of Agriculture ;
- (ii) National Diploma in Technology in Agriculture from the Hardy Institute, Ampara ;

Note.— If the applicants who have obtained a Diploma from the Open University of Sri Lanka have obtained the basic Qualifications for relevant Diploma of the same University, they will be exempted from the requirement of passing the G. C. E. (O/L) Examination.

07. *Mode of Recruitment.*—The candidates who have fulfilled the basic requirements will have to sit for a competitive examination conducted by the Department of Examinations as decided by the Director, Export Agriculture. A candidate will be required to obtain a minimum of 40 percent or more in each paper at the competitive examination for the recruitment to the post of Extension Officer. The candidates who have obtained the highest marks will be called for an interview in order to check the qualifications depending on the number of vacancies exist at the time of recruitment. No marks will be given for the interview. The candidates who have fulfilled the requirements and have obtained highest marks for the two subjects will be recruited

in accordance with the provision of the Public Administration Circular No. 15/90.

08. The examination will be held in Sinhala, Tamil and English. Candidate must answer all the papers of the examination in one language.

09. The examination will consist of two papers :

- (i) General Intelligence ;
- (ii) Question Paper in Technology.

- (6) Agricultural Policies, Past, Present and Future Potentials.
- (7) Export Agricultural Crops—Botanical information, Climatic factors, Soil, Fertilizer effects and nutrition, Pests and Diseases, and Post Harvest Technology relevant to Pepper, Cinnamon, Coffee, Cocoa, Cardamoms, Cloves, Nutmeg, Betel and Arecanut.
- (8) Marketing and export potentials for Export Agricultural Crops.
- (9) Organic farming.
- (10) Farm management, plant production and nursery management.
- (11) Agricultural extension methods and extension methodology.

10. *Examination Fees.*—A Money Order to the value of Rs. 200 should be attached to the application and forward to the Director, Export Agriculture in his favour to be payable at the Post Office, Peradeniya. Applications sent without the Money Order will be rejected. The examination fees will not be refunded.
